## Seminole Tribe of Florida Hollywood Raw Water Supply Improvements

Hollywood, Florida



### Background

The Seminole Tribe of Florida constructed two new water supply wells (Wells 4 and 5) at the Hollywood Reservation. This project included installation of well pumps and approximately 1,050 linear feet of raw water main (8" to 14" diameter) from the new pumps to the existing main at the Hollywood Reservation Water Treatment Plant. Each well head is per STOF's standard design including valve train with flow metering and adjacent control and power panels. The above ground equipment at each well head is enclosed by a decorative wall matching or complimenting the adjacent existing wall. Standby power is provided to the well pumps from existing generators at the treatment plant. The existing acid injection system at Well No. 2 was relocated to a common location to serve Wells No. 2, 4 and 5.

## The Project

The scope of services for project included the following components:

- Permitting and licensing for the project.
- Design and preparation of construction documents.
- Bidding services.
- Construction cost estimates.
- Construction administration and project management.
- Submittal of shop drawings.
- Permitting assistance.
- Site visits and field investigation.
- Services during the construction, close-out and post-construction phase.

The design phase and permitting have been completed. The construction contract has been awarded and the estimated construction completion is June 2019.
